Troup County to Hold Second Public Briefing to Discuss Unified Development Ordinance (UDO)

Troup County, Ga. March 26, 2019 – Troup County is hosting its second public briefing on Thursday, April 11, 2019 from 5:30PM-7:00PM to further discuss changes to County development and zoning codes. The meeting will be held at the LaGrange-Troup County Chamber of Commerce, 111 Bull Street, LaGrange, GA 30241.

While the first public briefing allowed citizens the opportunity to give feedback on current and future development, this community forum will present a summary of the community input received to-date and offer an opportunity to discuss how the development, zoning codes, and subdivision regulations could be further improved. The consultant team will also present an overview of the key recommendations for the proposed new Unified Development Ordinance.

Troup County is currently in the process of updating County regulations pertaining to development ordinances and zoning codes to develop a Unified Development Ordinance (UDO). The county would like to encourage the community to attend in order to contribute feedback for the overall improvement of Troup County.
