## Qualifications/Knowledge:

- Knowledge of emergency communication principles and practices
- ► Knowledge of GCIC/NCIC policies and procedures
- ➡ Knowledge of emergency dispatch procedures
- Rnowledge of radio and telecommunications equipment
- Rnowledge of CAD system functions and maintenance
- ⇒ Skill in the use of computers and job-related software programs
- Skill in making decisions in high pressure and emergency situations
- Skill in public relations
- Skill in interpersonal relations
- Skill in oral and written communications

## Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Receives and screens incoming calls from the public and other user agencies; categorizes and prioritizes calls including 911 calls
- Determines and dispatches the appropriate emergency personnel to incident locations; provides emergency medical instructions to callers prior to the arrival of responders as needed
- Receives, monitors and dispatches radio traffic for specific fire, EMS and law enforcement agencies
- ⇒ Inquires, retrieves and monitors data from GCIC/NCIC databases; ensures compliance with rules and regulations
- ➡ Maintains contact with emergency personnel in the field
- Responds to driver's license and vehicle information requests
- ➡ Monitors channels for other agencies
- A Monitors weather conditions and provides information as necessary; dispatches severe weather alerts as appropriate
- ➡ Operates Code Red messaging system
- ➡ Participates in training exercises
- Dispatches wrecker services to accident scenes
- ➡ Performs all other related duties as assigned
