- ➡ Knowledgeable of first aid techniques and procedures
- Skill in swimming, lifesaving and first aid
- Ability to exercise tact, judgment and patience in maintaining order and discipline in enforcing regulations
- Excellent verbal, written and interpersonal communication skills
- ➡ Must be able to work weekends as required
