Qualifications/Knowledge:

- ⇒ Minimum of 1-2 years of experience in a related field is preferred
- ⇒ Knowledge of the techniques, equipment and supplies used in road maintenance
- ⇒ Knowledge of county and departmental safety policies and procedures
- ⇒ Knowledge of the geography of the county, including road names and locations
- ⇒ Skill in the operation of assigned vehicles, trucks and equipment
- ⇒ Skill in prioritizing and organizing work
- ⇒ Skill in the use of hand and power tools

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- ⇒ Operates a low-boy truck, water truck, dump truck, flat-bed truck and other trucks to transport materials to and from work sites

- ⇒ Flags traffic at work sites
