Therefore, the Superior Court of Troup County, Georgia shall be closed Friday January 10th, 2025 or until further order of the court provided this order is not extended or otherwise modified the Superior Court will re-open for normal operations on Monday, January 13th, 2025 at 8:00 a.m.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to O.C.G.A. §38-3-62, all court deadlines, time schedules or filing requirements are hereby suspended, tolled, or extended for the duration of the judicial emergency as noted above; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Sheriff, or his designee, shall post a copy of this order on the Superior Court doors; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Superior Court, or her designee, shall immediately notify the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court and the Clerks of the Court of the Appeals and Supreme Court by sending them a copy of this Order; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERDED that the County Administrator, or his designee, shall post a copy of this Order and any subsequent modification or extension in accordance with O.C.G.A. §38-3-63 on the county website or other appropriate public address system
