Board of Elections & Registration Encourages Voters to Remain Aware of Third Party Election-Related Mailings

Troup County, Ga. August 21, 2020 – The Troup County Board of Elections & Registration would like to encourage voters to remain aware of third party election-related incoming mailings with specific requests related to voting in the upcoming November General Election, as well as phone calls and text messages.

The Troup County Elections and Registration Office has received numerous inquiries from concerned voters with questions regarding documents they have received via mail from third parties. Third-party political and advocacy groups are urging residents to request absentee ballots via mail or register to vote ahead of the November General Election. These documents have not been sent out by the Troup County Elections and Registration Office. This is common before an upcoming election, but it does not require any correspondence from voters.
