Troup County, Ga. June 2, 2020 – The Troup County Board of Commissioners is pleased to announce Mrs. Sonya Conroy has been named Chief Finance Officer, effective June 3, 2020.

Since January 2020, Conroy has acted as Troup County Interim Chief Finance Officer. Before accepting the position of Interim Chief Finance Officer, she served as Troup County Assistant Finance Officer for over twenty-one years. Her proven success and skills in financial reporting, sales and excise tax distributions, grant fund accounting, and budgeting have been demonstrated through more than thirty years of professional experience in financial and accounting services.

“I am extremely pleased to have been given the opportunity to oversee the financial and accounting services of the county. I am eager to continue to provide leadership to these imperative services, as well as to offer guidance and development to Finance staff members,” said Conroy. In discussing future challenges, she recognizes the difficulty of measuring the extent of the COVID-19 economic impact, “During my employment with Troup County, I have seen downturns and upswings in the economy and in the county’s financial position; therefore, I feel confident that my prior experience has prepared me for this role.”

As Chief Finance Officer, she will be responsible for advising county personnel on financial matters; coordinating the development of the county’s annual operating and capital budgets; managing cash balances, revenues and expenditures to ensure compliance with budget objectives; overseeing millage rates for the taxation of property; managing the proceeds from special purpose local option sales taxes; and overseeing the administration of grant programs.
