

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NOTICE

NATATORIUM DEHUMIDIFIER & LOCKER ROOMS HVAC SYSTEM

The Troup County Board of Commissioners is soliciting sealed proposals for the replacement of the HVAC system for the locker rooms adjacent to the natatorium at the Mike Daniel Recreation Center. All bids must be submitted in sealed packaging clearly marked "NATATORIUM DEHUMIDIFIER & HVAC SYSTEM". All bids must include a 5% bid bond. A 100% performance and payment bond will be required from the successful proposer. The sureties must either be authorized by the Insurance Commissioner of Georgia to do business in Georgia or must be on the United States Treasury's list of approved bond sureties. If the surety is on the United States Treasury's list, proof must be provided with the bond.

A current certificate of insurance providing proof of general liability, automobile and workers compensation must be on file with Troup County Purchasing Department for the duration of the project and throughout the warranty period.

All proposals must be received no later than 11:00 a.m., Thursday, March 28, 2019 in the Troup County Purchasing Department, 100 Ridley Avenue, Suite 3100, LaGrange, GA 30240. **LATE BIDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

There will be a mandatory pre-bid conference on site, Mike Daniel Recreation Center, 1220 LaFayette Parkway, LaGrange, GA 30241, March 14, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.
