Troup County Board of Commissioners is soliciting sealed bids for the South Thompson Road Bridge Replacement at Polecat Creek. Bids will be accepted until 2:00 p.m. **September 23, 2019** in the Troup County Purchasing Department, 100 Ridley Avenue, Suite 3100, LaGrange, Georgia 30240. All bids must be sealed and clearly marked South Thompson Road Bridge Replacement at Polecat Creek. At the time and place noted above the proposals will be publicly opened and read.

Contacting any other party for information will require that any bid submitted by said bidder being ruled non-responsive. No requests or questions will be allowed after **September 17, 2019**. All work shall be done in accordance with the bid documents, specifications and drawings. If bid response forms are provided, your response must be submitted on these forms.

Bidders are expected to examine carefully the work sites, the specifications, conditions, etc. before submitting a bid. The submission of a bid shall be considered evidence that the bidder has made such examinations and is satisfied as to the conditions to be encountered in performing the work..

South Thompson Road Bridge Replacement at Polecat Creek Project is to be completed within 90 consecutive calendar days.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after time has been called on the date of the opening. **Bid Bond is not required.** Both a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond will be required in the amount equal to 100% for the contract price from the successful bidder. The bonding surety must be either authorized by the Insurance Commissioner of Georgia or be on the United States Treasury's list of approved bond sureties.

All bids submitted must include a certificate of insurance showing general liability, automobile, workers compensation and employer's liability coverage with limits of \$1,000,000.00 minimum per type of insurance.

Each bid must include a notarized affidavit providing your e-verify registration number, a W-9 and the Troup County vendor information form. These forms are all available at [www.troupcountyga.org](http://www.troupcountyga.org)

The Troup County Board of Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive any formalities and award the contract in a manner consistent with Troup County's best interest. All bids will be opened and read aloud and shall be signed by an individual with the Bidding Company authorized to execute contracts on behalf of the Bidding Company. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the date of the Bid Opening. The successful bidder shall be required to provide comprehensive and liability insurance wherein the County is named as co-insured. The contractor is also required to provide Workmen's Compensation Insurance. The decision of the Board of County Commissioners, Troup County with regard to award of the bid is final.
