If you make a mistake or change your mind on a selection:

- A. Do not attempt to mark through the selection or attempt to erase. Write "Spoiled" across the ballot and across the return envelope
- B. Mail or return the spoiled ballot and envelope to your county board of registrars; a new official absentee ballot will be mailed to you

If you decide to vote in-person: Surrender the ballot to the poll manager of an early voting site within your county or the precinct to which you are assigned. You will then be permitted to vote a regular ballot

I understand that the offer or acceptance of money or any other object of value to vote for any particular candidate, list of candidates, issue, or list of issues included in this election constitutes an act of voter fraud and is a felony under Georgia law. Authorizes dedication of fees and taxes to their intended purposes by general state law.

House Resolution 164
Act No. 597

*Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to authorize the General Assembly to dedicate revenues derived from fees or taxes to the public purpose for which such fees or taxes were intended?

Act No. 149

AMEND TROUP COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION AD VALOREM TAXES
(Vote for One)

Shall the Act be approved which provides for a \$40,000.00 homestead exemption from all Troup County School District ad valorem taxes for educational purposes for residents who are 55 years of age or over and who have annual incomes not exceeding \$22,000.00 be amended to provide that a person who is 65 years of age or over is granted an exemption on that person's homestead and not more than two contiguous acres of homestead property from Troup County School District ad valorem taxes for educational purposes in the amount of \$40,000.00 of the assessed value of that homestead, if that person's annual income, together with the annual income of the spouse of such person who resides within such homestead, does not exceed \$40,000.00 for the immediately preceding taxable year? Annual income shall include retirement benefits, disability, pension, and Social Security benefits. The value of that property in excess of such exempted amount shall remain subject to taxation.* All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and all persons desiring to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No."
