### TROUP COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT

#### **Statistics:**

- 12 Fire Stations
- 57 Full-Time Firefighters
- 10 Part-Time Firefighters
- 18 Volunteer Firefighters
- Responds to nearly **3,500** calls per year

#### **ISO Rating**

- The Current Insurance Services Organization (ISO) rating is 4/4y, originally decreased from 5/5x in August 2018.
- With the addition of Truck 1, this should assist in a reduction of the next ISO rating to a possible 3.



• The current ISO rating continues to offer residents of Troup County a lower annual insurance premium cost than the previous rating of 5/5x.

## TRAINING PROGRAMS AND INITIATIVES

#### **CPR/AED Course:**

• The Troup County Fire Department (TCFD) continues to host quarterly CPR/AED classes as part of the community outreach program.

#### FF1 Class:

• Started a FF1 class for all personnel that were not at National Professional Qualification (NPQ) Level.

#### FF2 Class:

 Started NPQ FF2 class for all personnel who have completed FF1.

#### Firefighter Cancer Reduction Program:

 Started the new Firefighter Cancer Reduction Program with First Step.

## TRAINING PROGRAMS AND INITIATIVES

#### **Farm Medic Course:**

• A Farm Medic course was instructed at TCFD to better prepare our firefighters and EMT's for incidents.

#### **Aquatic Training:**

 Partnered with Troup County Parks and Recreation to practice firefighting emergencies involving pools.

#### Livestock Emergency Response Training

#### NPQ Aerial Operator

#### Recruit Training:

- Recruits are sent to Georgia Fire Academy where they train for eight weeks before being assigned to a station.
- Training Division continues training to meet ISO & Fire Academy standards.

#### **Procedure Updates:**

Developed new at-scene command procedures.



# PUMP AND HOSE TESTING/MAINTENANCE

 All TCFD Pumpers and Hoses are tested annually to meet quality National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) and Insurance Services Organization (ISO) standards.

• Firefighters consistently train with the pumping apparatus in different situations due to the various water supply variables they face.



## EQUIPMENT UPGRADES

# HURST eDRAULICs Extrication Equipment:

 Purchased 4 sets of the new HURST eDRAULICs Extrication Equipment.

# MagneGrip Exhaust Removal System:

• Purchased to protect firefighters from carcinogens emitted by the diesel exhaust from the apparatus inside the bay area.

#### Gear Extractor:

• A \$5000 incentive has been received from Georgia Risk Management to go toward the purchase of a new gear extractor which will clean/wash up to 4 sets of turnout gear at a time.







## EQUIPMENT UPGRADES

#### New Aerial Apparatus:

 Received approval from the Troup County Board of Commissioners for the purchase of a new Aerial Apparatus which is in service and responding to calls.

#### **New MAKO Air Machine:**

- Purchased a new MAKO Air Station as part of the Safety Program which is in place and being utilized.
- Possesses the capability to fill cylinders to a maximum pressure of 6000 psi, increased from the 2216 psi maximum of the old machine.
- Old air station will be re-conditioned and moved to another fire station.





### COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS

- TCFD works hand-in-hand with other departments to make Troup County a better place to live and work.
- \* Troup County Firefighters provide support for Toys for Tots, assembling bicycles and assisting with seasonal Toy Drives.
- TCFD also works with EMS and Air Evac. Services to provide safe landing zones and top quality EMS care.
- TCFD and Troup County AMR began a Basic EMT class for 18 firefighters and we are proud to say all 18 have completed the program. This will add more EMT's to operations and increase TCFD's ability to provide pre-hospital care and services.

# CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

#### Pyne Road Park Camp Grounds Improvements:

- Parks and Recreation was awarded the GNR Land and Water Conservation Grant and used the \$100,000 to complete upgrades to the Pyne Road Park Camp Grounds.
- Upgrades included reworked plumbing and electricity, newly paved driveways, and the addition of electric gates, fire pits, and new pea gravel.
- Campsites are available for tent and RV rentals, offer easy access to West Point Lake, and are in close proximity to the multi-use trails.







# CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

#### Multi-Use Trail Upgrades at Pyne Road Park:

- Received a matching \$100,000 grant from the Georgia Department of natural Resources (DNR) for improvements to existing multi-use trails at Pyne Road Park.
- Trails enhancements, being made in an effort to increase sustainability for hikers, bikers, and horses, include:
  - Trail alignment adjustments to repair erosion and to mitigate further weather damage.
  - An electric gate to provide more security.
  - Establishment of appropriate directional and safety signage.
  - ➤ Improved emergency access for EMS/Extraction services.
- These trails have an estimated "grand opening" date of May 2022.




## OAKFUSKEE CENTER AT PYNE ROAD PARK

  - > An outdoor amphitheater







- Awarded a \$2 million grant from the Callaway Foundation for the construction of Phase I of the Renovation.

- Sounds System, technology, and assistance provided by Liberty Technology.








### UPGRADES AND UPDATES



# LAGRANGE-CALLAWAY AIRPORT

- LaGrange-Callaway Airport (LGC) plays a critical role in supporting major employers in the area.
- Several Corporations frequent LaGrange and Troup County via LGC monthly for reasons listed below:

### **OVERVIEW**

- LGC has a variety of aviation businesses located on-site:
  - Southside Aviation aircraft maintenance and repair services
  - AirVentures flight training, instrument training, flight reviews, scenic flights and rides
  - Brown Aero flight instruction
  - ➤ Air Evac offers 24 hour ambulance operations for the region
  - Civil Air Patrol, EAA and a Flying Club
- The LaGrange-Callaway Fixed Base Operator (FBO) is operated by Troup County:
  - Number of Based Aircraft: 68
  - ➤ Hangar Waitlist: 30/Our hangars are completely full
  - Annual Enplanements: 7,400
  - Annual Operations: Approx. 14,000

• Remodeled the sign for LaGrange-Callaway Airport, incorporating brick and the Troup County logo.




