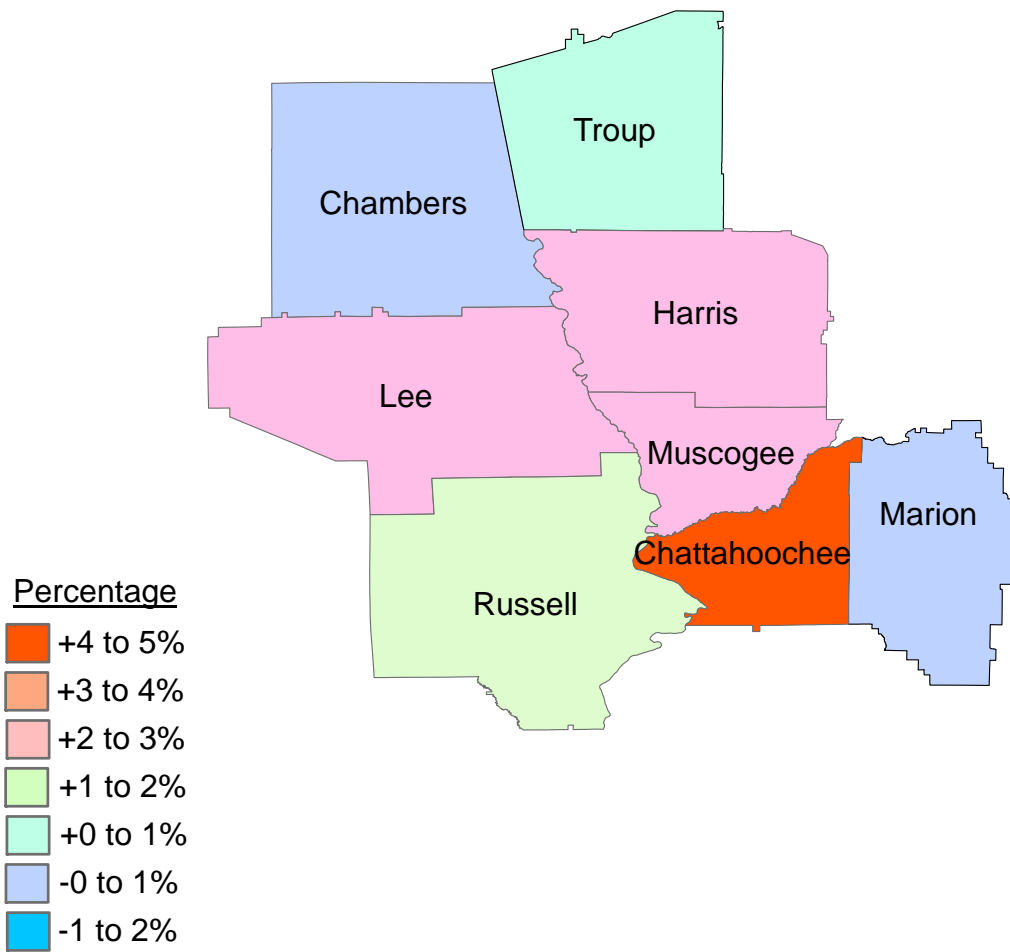


COLA Economic Region Population Change 2008 - 2009
