## Preservation Planning for LaGrange's HAMILTON ROAD HISTORIC DISTRICT

The historic Hamilton Road Historic District is LaGrange's historic African American community, with its establishment dating to the late nineteenth century. The neighborhood was recognized as a significant historic district by the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT), during GDOT's project planning for improvements to SR 1/US 27/Hamilton Road. The district is significant for its variety of late-nineteenth to mid-twentieth century houses, commercial buildings, and churches, as well as for the educators, physicians, business leaders, and other prominent members of this historic black community that built their businesses and homes there.

### WHY A PRESERVATION PLAN?

A preservation plan is being prepared for the historic community to provide its residents with the tools to pursue the preservation of the district's important landmarks. Preservation plans are designed to analyze the existing conditions of historic properties, identify the issues the properties are facing such as vacant, deteriorating buildings and encroaching development, and provide an outline of tools and resources that the community can use to address these concerns. Information about economic incentives, heritage tourism projects, local zoning, and recognition of the district in the National Register of Historic Places will be included in the plan.
