The Troup County Board of Commissioners is accepting sealed bids for an infilled synthetic turf system for Callaway Stadium, 800 Dallis Street, LaGrange, GA 30240. Bids must be submitted to the Troup County Purchasing Department, 100 Ridley Ave., Suite 3100, LaGrange, GA 30240, in a sealed envelope clearly marked "Infilled Synthetic Turf System" no later than **3:00 p.m., May 23, 2016. Late bids will not be accepted.** One original and two copies are to be submitted with each response.

A bid bond for 5% of the total submitted bid must be included with each bid. A 100% performance and payment bond will be required from the successful bidder. All sureties must be authorized by the Insurance Commissioner of Georgia to do business in Georgia or must be on the United States Treasury's list of approved bond sureties. The surety must provide proof of authorization by the Insurance Commissioner of Georgia to do business in Georgia or proof of its being on the United States Treasury's list of approved bond sureties. Each bidder must provide proof of general liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000.00, automobile insurance and workers' compensation insurance.
