Discuss request to fill two part-time seasonal positions in Parks &

Recreation:

County Manager Tod Tentler requested two part-time seasonal positions are filled at Parks & Recreation. The two positions would be seasonal employees that consist of 10 hours a week for 8 weeks.

Discuss budget amendment for hazardous materials response maintenance

grant:

Chief Jerry Heard presented a budget amendment for hazardous materials response grant. Mr. Heard stated this was a state grant for 10k and that any expense the county purchased for mask, suits and the maintenance agreement to enhance the equipment would be reimbursed to the county.

Discuss AT&T cell tower application for Vernon Ferry Road:

Chairman Wolfe announced the county attorney advised that in the last regular meeting The AT&T cell tower application for Vernon Ferry Road was not disposed of by no show of hands in favor of or denied so he felt the need to start the process again. American Tower Company did not think the county gave proper notice as to why it was denied when it was approved in the zoning process. Sr. Deputy Building Official Mr. Brandon Johns presented a timeline that started on March 23. At the August 7th meeting no formal action was taken so from our consultant's opinion, we are still within the shot clock. (150 days from the start of the process)
