City of LaGrange/ Sandtown Road Annexation Request:

County Engineer James Emery announced the City of LaGrange notified the county of an annexation of 312 acres north of Sandtown Road on December 12, 2013. On December 18, 2013, Troup County sent a letter stating intent to object to the General Industrial zoning of the property. On January 7, 2014, the staff of Troup County, City of LaGrange and City of West Point met to try and come to agreement on mitigating the adverse impacts to unincorporated residents.

Grayhill Convenience Center Improvements:

County Engineer James Emery presented an update to the commissioners of the new improvements to the Grayhill Convenience Center.

Discuss 2014 Election Qualifying Fees:
