The Troup County Board of Commissioners is accepting sealed bids on four (4) - 50' light poles and thirty-six (36) -1000 watt metal halide light fixtures that will be sold as one (1) lot. These items are located at the McCluskey Tennis Center, 100 Hunnicutt Place, LaGrange, GA 30240. These items can be seen during regular business hours of Monday thru Friday, 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., but to do so you must schedule the visit with Diana Evans, Purchasing Director, 706-883-1635. Bids will be accepted until 2:00 p.m., Thursday, September 22, 2016 in the Troup County Purchasing Department, 100 Ridley Avenue, Suite 3100, LaGrange, GA 30240. All bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked "Surplus Property-Light Poles and Fixtures Bid". No bids will be accepted after 2:00 p.m. Bids must be submitted on this form.

These items are sold "AS IS" with no warranty. If you are tax exempt, a copy of your exemption certificate must accompany your bid. Sales tax will be added to the successful bid price if a certificate is not provided. The **MINIMUM** bid that will be accepted is **\$2,200.00**. Any/all bids submitted will be for all the items. Any bid below this minimum will be rejected.

The successful bidder will be required to submit payment in full within 10 days of notification that their bid has been accepted. Payment must be made in the Troup County Purchasing Department. The poles and fixtures cannot be removed from the property until payment is made. After payment has been made, the poles and fixtures must be moved within 30 days during the normal business hours of operation for the McCluskey Tennis Center given above. It is the sole responsibility of the successful bidder to remove these items from the property. Troup County has no liability for incidents that might occur in the removal process and if Troup County property is damaged during the process, it is the sole responsibility of the successful bidder to repair all damage to the County's satisfaction.

Troup County reserves the right to accept or reject any/all bids or make any decisions deemed to be in the best interest of Troup County.
