

REQUEST FOR BIDS

CRACK REPAIR AND RESURFACE (2) HOGANSVILLE TENNIS COURTS

Troup County Board of Commissioners is soliciting bids for crack repair and resurfacing of two (2) tennis courts located at 611 East Main Street, Hogansville, GA.

There will be a **MANDATORY** pre-bid meeting at the court location on Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. A bid response sheet will be provided for all in attendance in the week following the pre-bid meeting.

Bids are due no later than 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 8, 2017. Late bids will not be accepted. Bids may be submitted via fax to 706-298-3646; by e-mail to devans@troupcoco.org; or delivered or sent to Troup County Purchasing Department, 100 Ridley Ave., Suite 3100, LaGrange, GA 30240.

Any questions regarding this request for bids shall be submitted to Diana Evans, Purchasing Director at devans@troupcoco.org. No questions may be submitted after 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, January 31, 2017.

Each bid must include a notarized affidavit providing your E-Verify registration number, a W-9 and the Troup County vendor information form. Should the contractor use subcontractors, the contractor will secure from the subcontractor(s) attestation of each subcontractor's compliance with O.C.G.A. § 13-10-90 *et seq.* The contractor agrees to provide the Troup County Board of Commissioners with all affidavits from any subcontractor engaged to perform services under any contract between the contractor and the Troup County Board of Commissioners within 5 business days of the subcontractor being hired. The Contractor shall procure and maintain General Liability Insurance, Automobile Liability Insurance as well as Workmen's Compensation Insurance for all of the employees to be engaged in work on the project.

Troup County reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all bids and to accept the bid which County personnel consider the most advantageous to the County. The County further reserves the right to waive informalities and minor irregularities in all bids received in the bidding process.
