Responds to fires, medical emergencies and other emergency situations to administer life support care to sick and injured persons and protects life and property.

The qualified candidate will have:

- ⇒ High school diploma or equivalent and one to two years related experience and/or training
- ⇒ State of Georgia Emergency Medical Technician Certification
- ⇒ Georgia Firefighter Standards and Training Council Certification
- ⇒ Excellent verbal, written and interpersonal communication skills
- ⇒ Knowledge of Microsoft software to include Excel and Word
- ⇒ No felony convictions or shall have been convicted of sufficient misdemeanors to establish a pattern of disregard for the law
- ⇒ Must have a current, valid driver's license with a good driving record and obtain within 12 months of employment the proper class of license to operate fire apparatus in the department
- ⇒ Must have the ability to read maps
- ⇒ Must have knowledge of two-way radio operation and codes
- ⇒ Ability to think clearly and act quickly in emergency situations and deal with the public in a positive manner
- ⇒ Must be able to work under stress
- ⇒ Must be able to meet physical requirements

Essential duties and responsibilities include the following:

- ⇒ Performs all duties of a Certified Firefighter and Emergency Medical Technician
- ⇒ Responds to fires, medical emergencies and other emergency situations to administer life support care to sick and injured persons and to protect life and property
- ⇒ Performs a variety of salvage and clean up operations
- ⇒ Utilizes various firefighting and emergency response equipment including fire apparatus, Jaws of Life, chain saws, air compressor, vent fans, Self Contained Breathing Apparatus and other related equipment
- ⇒ Keeps current on treatment techniques, protocol changes and application of new drugs, material and equipment
- ⇒ Prepares required reports and maintains records of activities
- ⇒ Participates in drills, demonstrations and courses in life support, emergency medical treatment and firefighting techniques
- ⇒ Responds to hazardous material spills
- ⇒ Searches buildings and rescues victims from buildings and motor vehicles using appropriate tools and equipment
- ⇒ Communicates with other medical personnel via radio
- ⇒ Performs all other related duties as assigned

A superior officer reviews work assignments and gives specific instructions and assistance or back up when needed. Work requires independent judgment and discretion in difficult or unusual situations. Work involves personal danger.
