NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Troup County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a 2022 millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 8.79 percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held in the Commission Chambers on the first floor of the Troup County Government Center, 100 Ridley Avenue, LaGrange, GA on June 21, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at Troup County Government Center, 100 Ridley Avenue, LaGrange, GA on June 21, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. and on July 6, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 9.769 mills, an increase of .789 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 8.98 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$175,000 is approximately \$53.65 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$175,000 is approximately \$55.23.
